

## HIGH BICKINGTON PARISH COUNCIL

### **Winter Weather and Grit Bin Policy**

**This policy has been adopted by High Bickington Parish Council**

1. In December inspection of the grit bins in and around High Bickington to check the condition of the rock salt and estimate the number of bags required to top up the bins. Also to check the designated areas where bags have been left.

These locations, at present are: The school play ground, The Church door way, The Community Shop, The Steps at Little Bickington. If other locations are identified they can be added to the list.

2. To liaise with the Snow Warden, at present Mr. Peter Tucker, to arrange delivery of the bags from our storage location (NFW) and to see if we need to order more bags
3. In January top up bins and replace bags as necessary.
4. When gritting is required four people have agreed to help spread the salt in those areas where ice is present -  
Peter Worrall & Steve Alford – village centre, Barton Meadow  
Jim Hutchings – Back Lane area  
Adam Bunting – Little Bickington Farm
